Each girl will be well prepared for life in the twenty-first century where communication, assisted by technological and multilingual expertise, will play an increasingly important role.

More than 90% of our Sixth Formers go on to Higher Education, an increasing number at Oxbridge.

Since the turn of the Century, 85 new Doctors and 138 new Medical and Scientific Researchers owe their success in part to the excellent secondary education they received at WGGG.

We can account for over 50 Maths and Engineering and over 70 Business Graduates and numbers in both continue to increase.

Degrees in Government and Politics have been awarded to 50 of our former students.

50 girls went on from WGGG to study and graduate in Law.
