## **Provider Access Policy**



## **Introduction**

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

## **Aims**

Our school aims to ensure that all pupils in years 8-13 are entitled:

- to find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point;
- to hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through options events, assemblies and group discussions and taster events;
- to understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

The school will also make available AV and other equipment to support the presentation. This will be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with the Head of Careers.

Providers are welcome to leave copies of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the Careers Library, which is managed by the Careers Assistant. The Careers Library is available to students all students at lunch and break times, and to Sixth Form students all day.

### **Opportunities for access**

A number of events, integrated into the school careers programme will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Please speak to our Head of Careers to identify an appropriate opportunity for you.

The school's policy on safeguarding sets out the school's approach to allowing providers into the school as visitors to talk to our students.
