GCSE and A Level Results

Your daughter will receive an email outlining all the arrangements for the publication of results two days before the day they are released which will be Thursday August 13th for A Level and Thursday August 20th for GCSE. Currently our expectation is that the vast majority of girls will not need to come on site.



Have Your Own Device

We have explained that, from September, we will be encouraging each student to bring a tablet or laptop to school. We recognise, however, that such devices are expensive, and we want to explore ways of supporting families who may struggle to purchase devices.
