<u>Key Stage 4 Core PE Assessment Criteria</u>

During Year 10 Students will have one practical core PE lesson per week where they will opt into different sporting pathways. They will also have 3 terms of Sports Leaders lessons where they will develop their leadership skills through a range of sporting activities. Our assessment in KS4 focuses on the skills and qualities they will be learning, rather than performance in specific sports,

Gold

Excellent at working in a team and confident to take of different roles when working in a team. Demonstrates a strong range of leadership skills and attempts to adapt these to suit the situation.

A very determined student who is willing to take risks, failure does not stop them, they keep trying to succeed.

Confident to follow and apply the rules to a range of sporting activities.

Demonstrates excellent sportsmanship and encourages others to follow their example. They are confident when implementing rules as an umpire.

Silver

Good at working in a team and attempts to take of different roles when working in a team. Demonstrates good leadership skills and applies these consistently when leading sessions.

A determined student who is willing to take risks, failure does not stop them, they keep trying to succeed.

Attempts to apply the rules to sporting activities and demonstrate sportsmanship. As an umpire they can apply rules in sports they have a confident understanding of.

Bronze

Can find working in a team difficult at times often taking on similar roles within the team. Demonstrates a basic leadership skill and attempts apply these consistently when leading.

The students sometimes need support and encouragement to take risks and overcome failure. Can apply basic rules to core sporting activities. They attempt to implement rules as an umpire but can often lack confidence.
